2008 Biggin Hill Air Show

It is that time of the year again - the Air Fair is almost upon us. This year the weekend of the 7th and 8th of June promises to be a great show (as always) and I'm sure most of you will attend at some stage if you are not living too far away.

For current members of the Biggin Hill Airport Social Club, you are reminded that the yellow "Airport" membership photocards are regarded as formal Air Show entry passes for the holder only - so please carry these and show them at the gate on entry. The holder may, of course, take their car into the main car park,

but all occupants must hold either a valid entry ticket or photo membership card. To avoid complicating matters, I suggest any non-members in a car are dropped just before the entry gate where they can walk through and purchase their tickets, meeting you on the other side of the gate, as this may save time. Gate staff will have a board at all entry gates showing all acceptable forms of entry ticket, and the club pass will be included on there. (Please bear in mind that staff may sometime not have seen the pass before, and will be unsure of the validity if this is the case, please explain that the pass is one of those on the boad showing all passes acceptable, as ask them politely to check. Please do not be rude to them or try to push your way through. They are doing their job, and should not be subjected to any abuse.)

JB and I have spent several months trying hard to obtain a location for a temporary bar on the airport for the period of the show, without success. We came very close to having something, but that final route was confirmed as unavailable to us only a few days ago. So, sorry that there is no formal watering hole on the airfield this year (we can only hope things are better next year!), and I hope that many of us will at least meet after the show each evening at the Jail pub in Jail Lane. (In fact, on the Saturday evening, we are trying to organise a special Airport gathering with some sort of Air Show special area outside in conjunction with the pub - more later this week, but keep the evening free if you can to join everyone there....)
